

**AMEDD Civilian Corps Chief Msg #35---Centrally Funded Education Opportunities (16 May 2013)**

Hola All,

Surprise, a second message in a week! Wanted to get this out to you ASAP because we have some good news to share!! As of today, Career Program dollars for training have been reinstated for the remainder of FY13. I encourage each of you, in conjunction with your supervisor, to review training listed on your Individual Development Plan and discuss training that you would like to be centrally funded. You need to do so quickly.

As usual, some restrictions apply:

- You need to apply as soon as possible but not later than 14 days prior to training.
- Because of the hold put on funding due to sequestration, we have a limited time to execute because these are FY 13 dollars. Training must be completed no later than 16 August 2013 to ensure availability of funding.
- We are emphasizing local opportunities and on line courses because attendance at Conference/Workshop/Group Training requires additional justification and approval by HQDA G-37 DAMO-TRV.
- We must also follow Secretary of the Army Guidance regarding travel, so training requiring TDY must follow TDY approval processes and be approved through local Command channels.
- Employees attending training via TDY must have a Government Travel Card. Sorry, we cannot grant any exceptions to this requirement.
- Rental cars will not be funded with CP53 training funds; however, Commands may fund a rental car.
- Employees may not travel until a Line of Accounting has been affixed to the SF182 by the DA G3 Budget Office.

NOTE: All funding is being handled by the CP management teams; do not contact the HQDA G-37 DAMO-TRV office.

BTW, there are no grade restrictions on the funding for CP 53. Hope many of you will take advantage of this opportunity so we can fully utilize available funding. Good luck!
