15 DEC 2015:

The application deadline is fast approaching for the MEDCOM Mentorship Pilot, open to GS1-GS10 (or equivalent) civilians as mentees and GS10 - GS15 (or equivalent) civilians as mentors. You are eligible whether or not you have completed any other training or developmental programs, including the Civilian Education System (CES) altho you will likely be challenged to do at least the on line portion during the mentoring period. We will fund the costs for a 1-week orientation at JBSA Fort Sam Houston, TX at the end of January for all participants. I encourage you apply today to take advantage of this opportunity!

It is that time of year again to apply for the AMEDD Executive Skills Course in April 2016. The course has been expanded to 2 weeks and will run from 4-15 April 2016 at Fort Sam Houston Texas. The application deadline is 10 February 2016. MEDCOM civilians in positions involving managed care who desire to develop and enhance their healthcare management capabilities are eligible and will attend this training with their military counterparts in other AMEDD Corps. The course specifically targets the roles and responsibilities associated with mid to senior level management positions where critical strategic thinking skills are important and includes a one-day breakout session with the Corps Chief Office to discuss Civilian Corps specific topics.
