A quick note. We've been working to develop a mentorship program for our AMEDD Civilian Corps. It will initially be focused on mentorship for 10-15 Corps members in grades GS 1-10 or equivalent, with the mentors being Corps members in grades GS 10-15 or equivalent, and will expand to our senior grades as the program develops. **BECOME A MENTEE:** AMEDD Civilian Corps Mentorship Program--Attention GS 1-10. If you are in grade GS10 (or equivalent) or below, you can apply to become part of a formal mentoring program for MEDCOM civilians. We are planning to launch the MEDCOM Mentoring Program in late January 2016 as a one-year pilot. This is an opportunity to gain from the experience and knowledge of other MEDCOM civilians to help manage your career and development. Your commitment would include a 2-3 day orientation currently scheduled for the last week in January 2016 and approximately 2 hours per month throughout the pilot. We are planning to launch the MEDCOM Mentorship Program near the end of January 2016 as a one-year pilot. This is an opportunity to use your experience and knowledge to help other MEDCOM civilians develop themselves and their careers. Your commitment would include a 2-3 day orientation, for which we will pay, currently scheduled for the last week in January 2016 and approximately 2 hours per month throughout the pilot. We need your help for the program to succeed and have put together a mentoring handbook and other tools to help you be a successful mentor.
